

The Finns Point Range Rear Light is a lighthouse in Pennsville Township,

Salem County, New Jersey. It is located just east of the Delaware River and was part of a Range light pair that guided ships into the Delaware River. Built in 1877, It's an example of a skeletal cast iron prefabricated lighthouse. Its companion Front range light was demolished and replaced with an offshore automated light in 1938. 
